

CGB-CBB Bursary for PhD students in Belgium attending CC10 in Antwerp

Call, Rules & Conditions

1. Purpose of the Bursary

The CGB-CBB Bursary call for attending the **10th EuChemS Chemistry Congress (ECC10)** in Antwerp (euchems2026.eu) is organized for supporting the active participation of young researchers in Belgium, being members of the Koninklijke Vlaamse Chemische Vereniging (**KVCV**) or the Société Royale de Chimie (**SRC**), in ECC10 by covering their registration fees. The goal is to encourage visibility of Belgian chemistry research and provide networking opportunities for PhD students.

2. Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- be a PhD student **affiliated with a Belgian university**,
- be a member of either **KVCV** or **SRC**,
- have an **accepted oral or poster presentation** at ECC10.

3. Scope of the Bursary

- The Bursary covers **100% of the early bird Student EuChemS member registration fee** for ECC10 (i.e. 425 €).
- The Bursary is paid **directly to the ECC10 organizers**, not to the individual student. A voucher will be issued to each Bursary laureate to register with ECC10.
- At least **20 bursaries** are available.

4. Selection Procedure

Step 1. Nomination at University level:

- Each Belgian university may nominate up to **three eligible PhD students**.
- The **nomination is made internally** involving all chemistry-related departments/faculties/institutes.

- The list of ranked candidates will be transmitted to the CGB-CBB by the **university representatives** by **March 24, 2026**.

If you are an eligible candidate, and you want to apply, submit the required documents to your university representative of CGB-CBB (see list below) by March 14, 2026.

Step 2. Granting the Bursary at CGB-CBB level:

- **The two first-ranked candidates of each university will be granted a Bursary.**
- **The third-ranked candidate may be granted a Bursary** by decision of the CGB-CBB Management Committee, which will make their selection to maximize coverage of the congress themes at ECC10, and in accordance with the budget allocated to the Bursary program.

Step 3. Confirmation of the Bursary:

- Final confirmation of granting the Bursary will be notified by CGB-CBB to the ranked PhD students, the CGB-CBB university representatives, and the ECC10 organizers **before March 30th, 2026**.

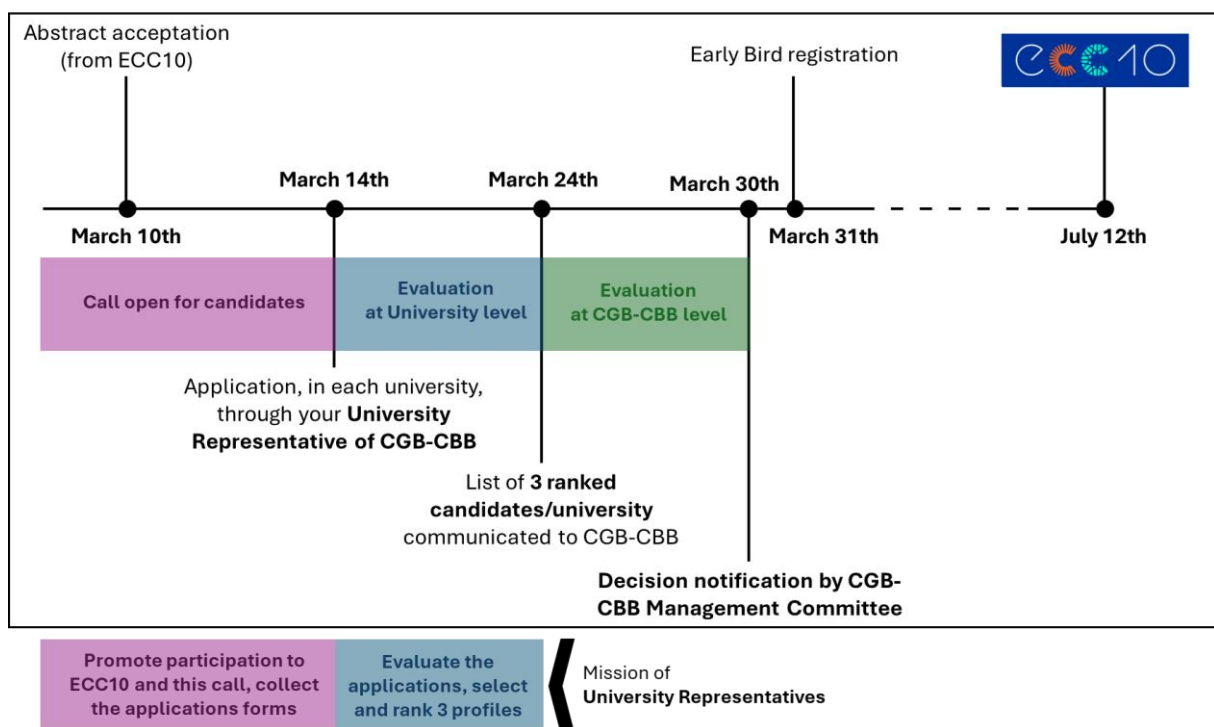
5. Visibility and Acknowledgement

- Bursary recipients agree to acknowledge the support of KVCV or SRC and CGB-CBB in their conference presentation/poster.
- KVCV and SRC reserve the right to publish the list of bursary recipients on their websites and communication channels.
- The laureates are invited to communicate within their social networks on their participation to ECC10 facilitated by a KVCV/SRC bursary.

6. Important Notes

- Bursaries are limited and subject to budgetary availability.
- Only **complete applications** submitted through the official university channels will be considered.
